Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

We have examined our hearts and brought our gifts to the altar. The gifts are now offered to the Father, by the priest, to be blessed (set aside). "Blessed are you, Lord God of all Creation, for through your goodness we have received the bread we offer you, fruit of the earth and work of human hands it will be come for us the bread of life. Blessed be God for ever." Then the priest offers a silent prayer as he pours water into the wine. Then we prays, "Blessed are you, Lord God of all creation, for through your goodness we have received the wine we offer you: fruit of the vine and work of human hands, it will become our spiritual drink. Blessed be God for ever." Finally, the priest offers another silent prayer with head bowed to God. Finally the gifts and the altar are offered to God through the use of incense. We begin with an ancient introduction, "Blessed are you Lord God of all creation." These words are rooted in ancient Jewish table prayers, words which would have been used by Jesus himself. They acknowledge God as sovereign and generous. He is sovereign of all

creation, for it is all His. He is generous because all we are offering to God has been given to us by God, "for through your goodness we have received (what) we offer you." We offer these items along with ourselves by offering the work of our hands. Finally we celebrate God's ability to recreate all we have offered to become so much more then we have given, the Bread of Life and our Spiritual Drink. No wonder we cry out - Blessed be God for ever! God's Peace!
